

## Health for Life at Our Lady of Fatima School

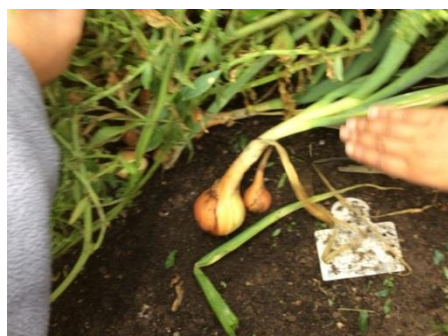
### Newsletter 5 – Autumn/Winter 2016



This term we have cleared all of the weeds which have grown in the raised beds. We have dug compost into the raised beds before covering them with black membrane to help deter the growth of weeds before they are used again for planting.



Year 3 has planted some spring bulbs and winter growing vegetables. Year 4 has planted garlic bulbs and onion seeds which they will be using to make garlic and onion bread in the summer term.



A variety of flowering bulbs have been planted in our wheelbarrow which will add colour to our school during the Spring and Summer. *A polite reminder:* please keep an eye on all toddlers and check they do not dig up our bulbs!
