

## Love Generously, Live Wisely, Think Deeply

As a school we always support CAFOD who help to support and provide for some of the world's poorest people with tools and resources they need to change their lives for the better. Our fundraising began in October 2016 following Year 5's Harvest Service. It continued in February 2017 with our fantastic 'Bake Off'.

In March 2017 the School Council met to discuss the ways in which they would like to spend the CAFOD donations. Altogether we raised £405 which was split between CAFOD and the Sudan crisis in North East Africa.

On **13<sup>th</sup> April 2017** we received a letter from Chris Funnell, the Head of the Supporter Donations Service thanking us for our donations and confirming how our donations had been allocated and spent.

**Trees for Life-** we supplied three families with five fruit tree saplings each, plus the tools and training to produce their own tree nursery. The trees will provide fresh, nutritious fruit and produce will also be sold at market to provide financial aid to the families.

**School Starter Pack-** a uniform, stationery, a school bag and every day items that will provide a child with gifts of education and opportunity helping them to reach their true potential.

**Water for a family-** a family will be able to enjoy a supply of safe, clean water for drinking, cooking, and washing, without the risk of catching deadly water-borne diseases.

**Vegetable Garden-** enough seeds will be provided for a whole year so that a family can grow their own vegetables to eat and sell.

**Community Toilet-** a latrine will be provided in a remote rural village, helping to address the issue of inadequate sanitation.
