

## **Sports Premium**

### **Primary School Sport Funding**

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.

Funding will be allocated to all maintained and state-funded schools with primary phase pupils, including: primary, middle, special and non-maintained special schools, academies and pupil referral units from 1 September 2013. A typical primary school will receive about £9,250 annually in the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

### **Use of Sports Premium Spending (Academic year 2013/14):**

The school received a grant of £5,438.00 for primary school sports in the academic year 2013 -14. This money was used in a number of different ways to support the provision of improved quality of sports and PE for all pupils.

At Our Lady of Fatima School during the year 2013/14, the funding was used to raise the profile of PE in the following ways. We

- increased children's participation in sports tournaments by subsidising the cost of travel when taking part in competitions
- provided staff training on how to teach PE well by purchasing a variety of extra teaching resources
- provided cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- released teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- forged links with the local community to help primary staff improve their PE and sports provision

- established an inter-school system to enable regular, school sports competitions for pupils of all ages
- provided extra, additional activities such as outdoor and adventurous activities
- ensured children became more physically active within PE lessons and at play times

To monitor impact and training needs, the PE coordinators from Key Stage One and Two meet each half term to discuss areas to develop and judge the measures already implemented.

A report will be drawn up that considers the overall impact of the previous year's funding. This report will be shared with governors at the end of each academic year.
