Q.8. Further discussions with pupils confirm that since working at 'age- related expectations', pupils are less confident in articulating their progress using 'age-related vocabulary. However, they do say that they fully understand how next steps, GAP tasks, marking, dialogue, feedback and targets help them to further improve.

Q.17 Some pupils said that they weren't always comfortable talking to a member of staff about issues that occur at home. They did, however, confirm that there are always adults available in school with whom they can talk, if they are worried about any issue at school, in class or during break times.
