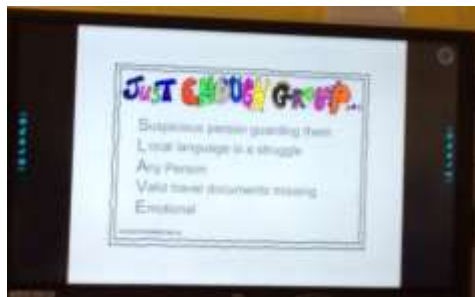


Modern Day Slavery Workshops

On **Thursday 5th September 2019**, Year 5 and Year 6 were visited by Sherina from the 'Just Enough Group'. Sherina spoke to the classes about Modern Slavery. She re-told stories of modern day slavery where different children in the class were chosen to act out scenarios and spot where slavery had taken place.

They were also given tips on how to raise awareness of spotting slavery e.g a person who has their travel documents missing, somebody who is suspiciously guarding someone else and more importantly how it could happen to anyone. What shocked Year 5 and 6 the most was that there are over 45 million slaves and 150 billion pounds is made through slavery even though it is illegal. The classes had a really interesting workshop today and will be keeping their eyes peeled for the signs!
