

On 28th January 2020, to celebrate Year 4's Class Saint's Day, they re-visited the life of Saint Thomas Aquinas and focused on his philosophical teachings.

They learnt that he tried to pair faith with science through reason. The children discovered that reasoning, linked to Maths is all about learning in different situations. They learnt about 'Natural Law' – the idea that they can learn and understand from the world around them; for example- learning to write. And 'Eternal Law'- the idea that God has an impact through divine intervention; for example- the arrival of the angels to Mary in the Annunciation.

Year 4 all understood that St Thomas believed that good ideas could come from anyone, regardless of their faith or their origin.
