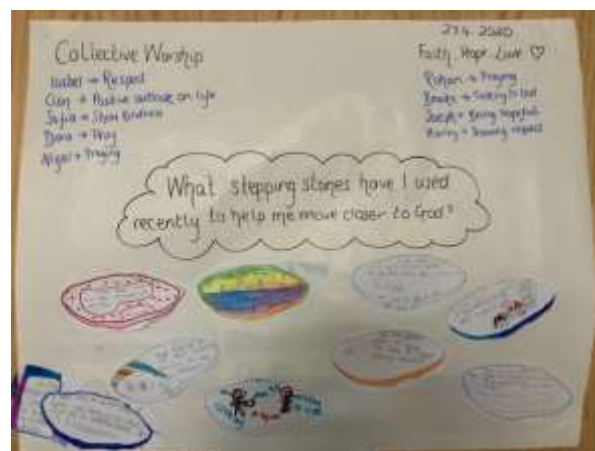


## Week beginning 27<sup>th</sup> April 2020

We looked at how we can develop our relationship with God by how we treat each other, following His example. We linked our learning to the Catholic Profile, sharing values and virtues amongst those we meet.



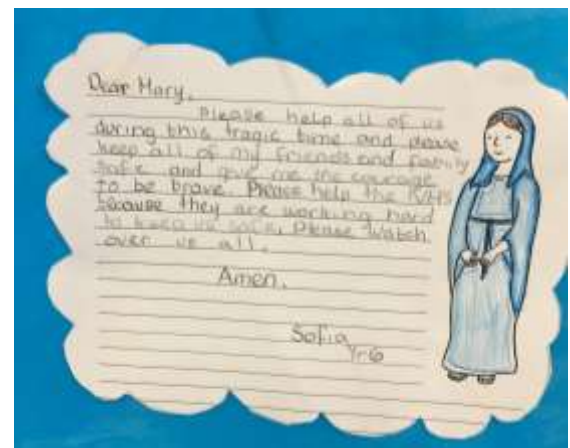
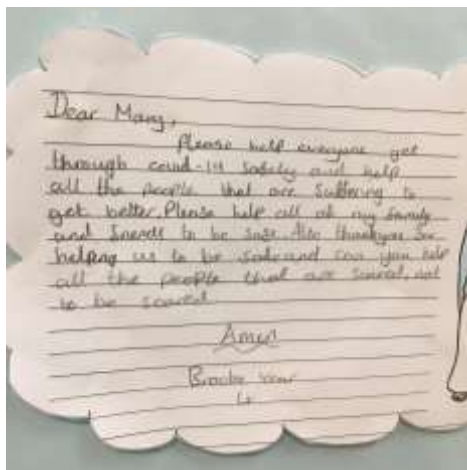
We discussed the responsibility we all have to look after our environment and its people, especially during these challenging times.
